Re: Public Records Request

Dear Madam/Sir:

I am writing in response to your request for records received by me on July 8, 2026, and your email correspondence to me dated July 14, 2026, and July 27, 2026. Please see responses below in bold to your streamlined scope of records requested:

“1. Network Sharing Configuration (SharedNetworks.csv): The dashboard export detailing which specific external agencies are granted access to Richmond's network, and which networks are shared back to Richmond. This configuration file contains zero license plates.

Please find the event-logs Excel sheet attached to this email.

2. Network Audit Log: The system-generated CSV export from the "Insights" tab detailing instances where external network partners queried Richmond's cameras. It is our understanding that when exported natively from FlockOS, this specific CSV automatically masks external operator names and license plate numbers with asterisks (**), requiring zero manual redaction by your staff.

The CSV file is too large to send in the email. Therefore, to provide you with the CVS file, we have placed it on a flash drive. The CVS file on the flash drive includes all open portions of this record. Several portions of this record are considered closed records pursuant to Section 610.100.3 and Section 610.021(19)(a) RSMo., and have been redacted accordingly. The flash drive containing the CSV file may be mailed if a mailing address is provided for

certified USPS delivery or can be picked up at Richmond's City Hall. The Richmond City Hall address is 205 Summit Street Richmond, Missouri 64085.

3. Event Log: The administrative action log detailing internal changes to network sharing settings or hotlist configurations.”

Please find the event-logs Excel sheet attached to this email.

There is no charge for the public records included with this letter. As noted above, the Network Audit CSV file is too large to send via email. The City has placed the Network Audit CVS File on a Flash Drive that you can either pick up at Richmond City Hall, or may be mailed to you via Certified USPS if a mailing address is provided.
